Chris Moller

Let's get this right Wellington!

'One size does not fit all - let's Design our City and avoid generic rezoning'.

In an age when we are learning to respect and celebrate diversity it's crucial that we design our urban environments in the same brave open spirit.

Good design revitalises urban spaces by keeping the best of our existing buildings while constantly adding new ingredients to transform the quality of our city.

Architect/Urbanist Chris Moller will illustrate his view with examples from New Zealand and abroad. He advocates the use of 'design research' and interactive design processes to create effective urban spaces which embrace and celebrate diversity, difference and density to create evolving livable cities.

Chris is a Wellington based architect/urbanist who worked for twenty years in Europe to establish an international competition winning practice. During this time he also tutored design at various European universities (including Housing and Urbanism at the Architecture Association, London). In addition he was Senior Urbanist for the city of Groningen in the Netherlands before returning to New Zealand to set up his practice CMA+U in Wellington. He was a founding board member of PrefabNZ. In 2014 he was asked to be the presenter of 'Grand Designs New Zealand' before resigning at the end of 2020 having completed six series."

National earthquake drill and tsunami hikoi (walk out), taking place on Thursday 28 October 2021 at 9.30am

Get Ready to Shake Out

Nau mai, haere mai! New Zealand ShakeOut is our national earthquake drill and tsunami hīkoi (walk out), taking place on Thursday 28 October 2021 at 9.30am. We invite you to join us on Thursday 28 October and practise your - DROP, COVER and HOLD- and tsunami hīkoi if your school, business or home is in a tsunami evacuation zone. If you aren't sure if you live, work or play in a tsunami evacuation zone you can check here.

What is New Zealand ShakeOut and tsunami hīkoi?

ShakeOut is held across the world to remind people of the right action to take during an earthquake — Drop, Cover and Hold — and to practise a tsunami hīkoi (evacuation) if in a coastal area.

How do I register for Shakeout?

To take part in the drill, sign up your school, workplace or household. It takes two minutes to sign up and we'll send you all the information you need to do the drill. Registrations can be done here.

Resources available for children:

If you are wanting to sit down and talk to your kids or even grandkids this ShakeOut about earthquakes and tsunami through story telling, then check out the bi-lingual children's book based on Kahungunu legends and dialect that teaches children about natural warning signs of tsunami.




